

**Register of valid applications for authorisation of recycling processes to produce recycled plastic materials and articles intended to come into contact with foods submitted to EFSA under art. 13 of Regulation (EC) No 282/2008**

The register contains the recycling processes for which a valid application has been received by EFSA during the initial authorisation phase. Applications should be received by the national contact point for applications on recycling processes by 31 December 2009.

Applications are considered as 'valid' when EFSA has accepted the application according to their administrative acceptance procedure (AAP positive). This means that the application contains the information specified in the guidelines for the safety assessment of a recycling process for plastics. Therefore, a certain delay can occur between the submission of the applications to the national contact point and their listing in the present register.

This register is being regularly updated. The date of last update is mentioned in the heading of this document. These recycling processes are not authorised at Community level.

The recycling processes have not necessarily been evaluated by EFSA. For the status of the safety evaluation please check the EFSA website [www.efsa.europa.eu](http://www.efsa.europa.eu).

Recycling processes and recycled materials and articles are still regulated at national level until their authorisation. Please consult the national authorities in the Member States to verify their legal status.

EFSA will issue an Opinion on each recycling process for which a valid application has been submitted before 1 January 2010.

Within six months of receiving all the opinions, the Commission will adopt a Decision granting or refusing authorisation of the recycling process. When the Community Register of authorised recycling processes under art. 9 of Regulation (EC) No 282/2008 is established, this register of valid applications will be deleted.

Recycling processes in this Register may continue to be used according to national legislation until the Commission has adopted a Decision granting or refusing authorisation of the recycling process.

Collection of personal data was done on the basis of the application dossier of the recycling process, which should contain the contact information of the business holder. The contact information of the business holder may or may not contain personal contact information.

Personal data are recorded and stored as long as follow-up actions are needed.

Your data will be handled in conformity with Regulation (EC) N° 45/2001 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data by Community institutions and bodies and on the free movement of such data.
